0930 Board the Jurassic Breezer at Swanage Station, make your way upstairs for great views of the Isle of Purbeck. Look out for that stunning castle view – it is one of our favourites, when you capture that first glimpse of Corfe Castle.

1037 Hop off the bus at Lulworth Cove, grab a quick comfort break and take a stroll around Lulworth, it has a couple of little gift shops and a stunning bay to enjoy.

If you are up for the challenge, why not take a hike up the coastal path and then make your descent down to Durdle Door. One of the most famous landmarks in Dorset. If you make it to the bottom hopefully you are ready with a picnic to enjoy on the beach. You may even be brave enough to take a dip. No jumping from the rocks though...

If you are worn out and don't want to trek back to Lulworth, you can sneak through the holiday park and catch the bus back on the main road at Durdle Door.
