Have your camera ready as you breeze past some of Dorset's most expensive homes as the bus drives through Sandbanks with its multi-million-pound properties. A harbourside mansion a stone's throw from the ultra-exclusive Sandbanks peninsula has recently sold for just under £16m - shattering the previous record for the area.

Then get ready for the most unique experience on a bus, as the bus boards the Swanage Chain ferry – a bus on a boat!

Just a short time over the other side and we recommend you get off at Knoll House Hotel.

There's plenty to discover with woodland walks out to the bird hides across the inland freshwater lake, Little Sea. Walk through the dunes to spot reptiles, heather and gorse.

If you packed your swimsuit, you could hire a sauna or watersports equipment from Studland Watersports or book in a foraging session or seaweed bath spa with Fore Adventure. The shallow, sheltered waters of Knoll Beach make it perfect for swimming and paddling.

From here walk out to Old Harry Rocks. Food in the evening can be found at Bankes Arm pub and Old Harry Bar in Studland Village serving pizzas (check their website for opening times/days).

hop back on the bus, sit back and relax after a hard day exploring (there are other timing options available if you want a shorter or longer day).
